

FORD/MAZDA DATA

Installation:

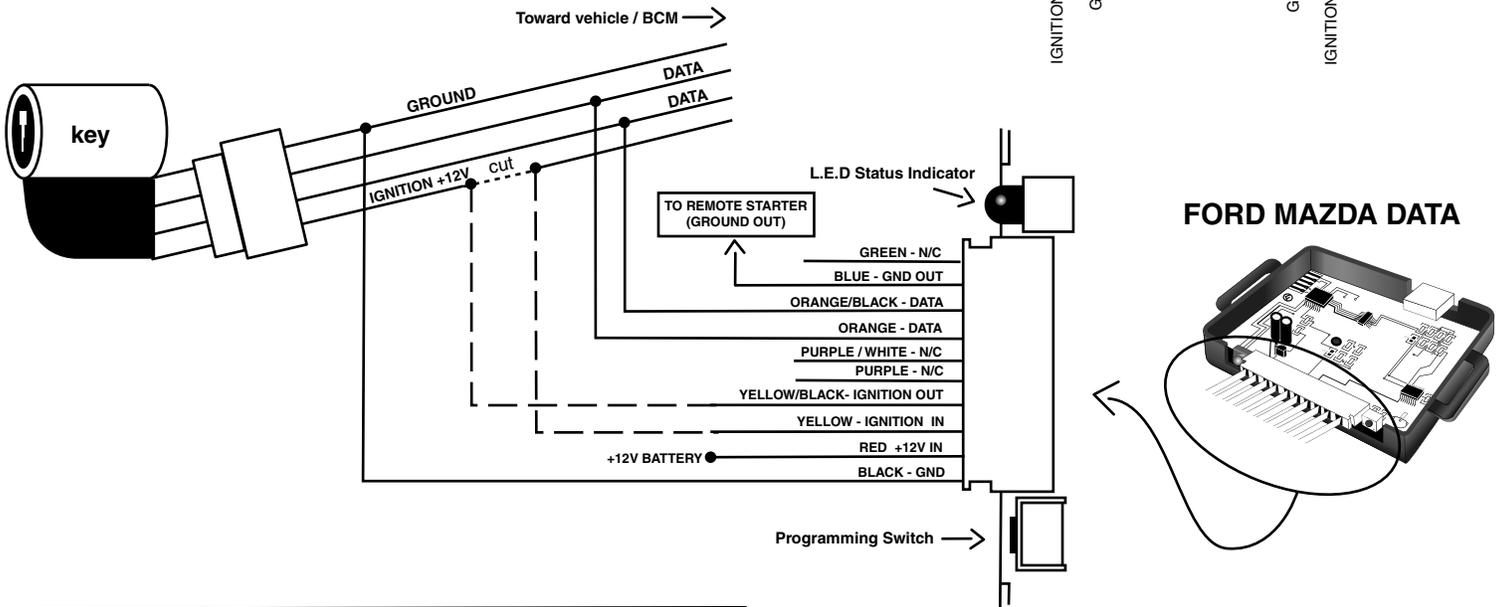
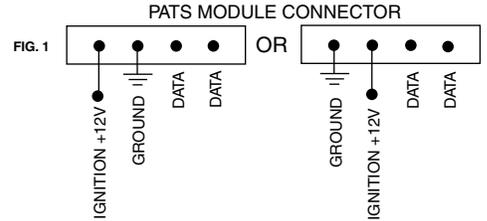
Find the vehicle connector as illustrated in Fig. 1. Determine the location of the ground wire to establish the type of connector in the vehicle. Once you have determined the location of the ground and 12V (ignition) wires, connect the remaining two wires to the FORD MAZDA DATA module data wires (the two data wires can be interchanged).

Next, "cut" the vehicle ignition (12V) wire and connect to the appropriate wires as indicated below.

Programming Procedure:

Press the programming switch while inserting the wiring harness into the module. Once the LED illuminates, start the engine with a functional vehicle key. The FORD MAZDA DATA MODULE will be programmed once the LED begins to flash. Once programmed, turn the engine off. The module is now in a normal functional mode. Remotely start the vehicle to insure functionality.

*The connector for the PATS module is located underneath the dash to the right of the steering column.
